



Edensor is part of the Chatsworth estate. The village dates back to at least the 11th century and was recorded in the Doomsday Book. In the late 18th century the 6th Duke of Devonshire remodelled the village. The village is characterised by a range of building styles which are unified by their scale and materials used. The village is surrounded by a gritstone wall and at its heart is St. Peter's church.

Edensor Conservation Area was designated in 1997.

Edensor is located within the estate lands of the Derwent Valley area of Peak District National Park (LSAP 2009).








The parish of Edensor has a population of 145 residents (2011 census).





Occupancy of Properties





Car/ Van Ownership


















Edensor Parish Boundary
