


Within the parish is the settlement of Grindon, a small settlement situated on the medieval pack-horse route from Ecton copper mines to Waterhouses and the Churnet Valley, and located at the southern end of the Peak District National Park, within Staffordshire Moorlands. Grindon was traditionally an agricultural settlement. It is linear in form with plenty of open grass verges which give it a pleasant open and spacious character. All Saints church sits at the highest point in the settlement and is a prominent landmark in the surrounding area.

Grindon is located within the upland pastures character area of the South West Peak (LSAP 2009).





Population and Demographics








Residency

Occupancy of Properties




Employment












Grindon Parish Boundary
