Section 1 – Form of Tender

- The 'tender return'
- This (and supporting documentation) will be evaluated by MFF



Section 2 – Form of Agreement

- "Intentionally left blank"
- Converts tender return into a contract
- Attached at the end of the tender package



Section 3 – Project Objectives, Detailed Specification and Conditions

- The where and how of works/supplies
- Split into 3 parts:
- Part A Project Objectives
- Part B Detailed Specification
- Part C Detailed conditions



Section 4 – Standard terms and conditions

- The "small print"
- Standard for all Moors for the Future contracts
- Ones to remember....



Section 5 – Information and instructions on submitting a tender
