

Hope with Aston Parish Statement (draft)



Hope village is located off the A6187, 1.5 miles east of Castleton and 4 miles west of Hathersage, within the High Peak District Council administration area. The village of Hope grew from the central crossroads which marks the junction of the north-south route from Edale to Bradwell (via Eccles Lane) with the east-west route along the valley (Hope Conservation Area Appraisal 2005). It has largely grown in a linear fashion, along the north side of the A6187 and along Edale Road.

Hope has a pre-school, primary school and a secondary school, which serves the wider area.

Hope is located within the Hope Valley, part of the Derwent Valley, an area characterised as valley farmlands with villages within the Peak District Landscape Strategy and Action Plan.

Aston is a small linear farming settlement located to the east of Hope. There has been a settlement here since before the Domesday survey in 1028. Aston Hall dates back to 1578 when the Balguys family lived there; prominent academics of high social standing in the Peak District area.

Aston is located within the valley farmlands and villages character area of the White Peak landscape (LSAP 2009).

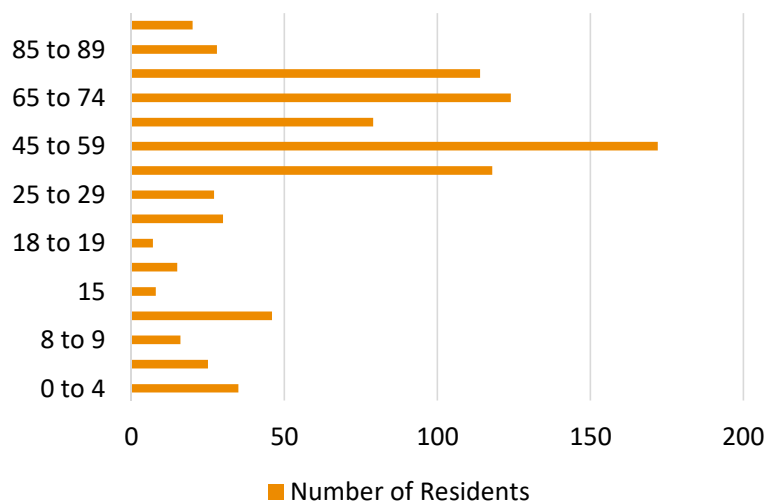


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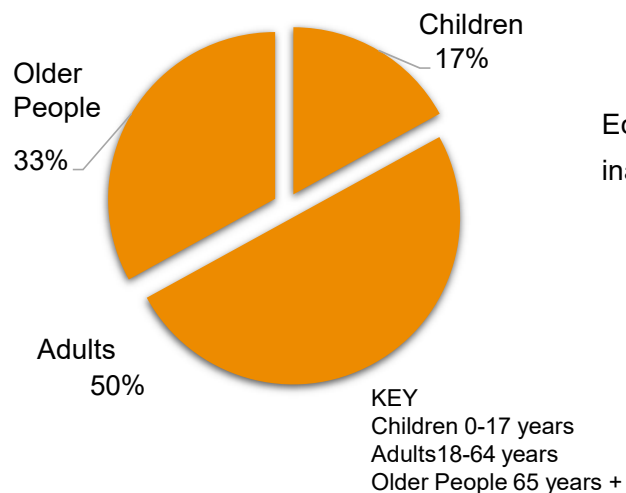


Population and Demographics

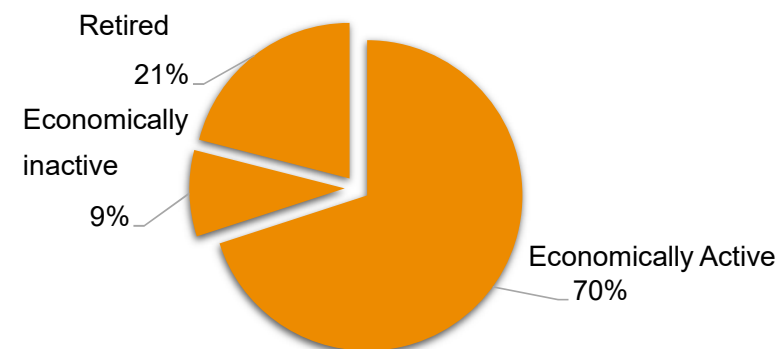
Population Age Range

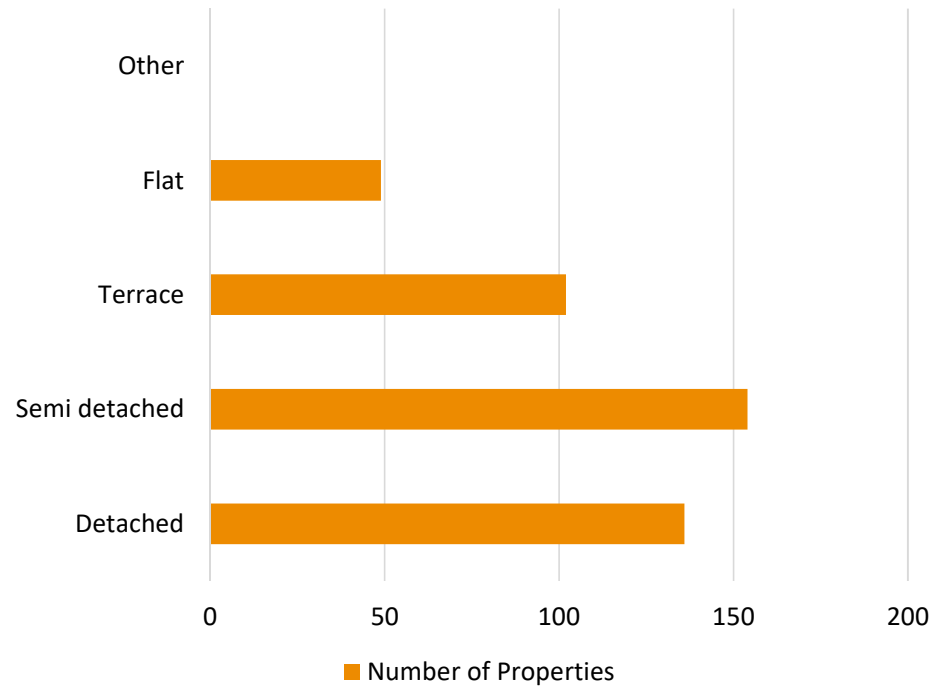

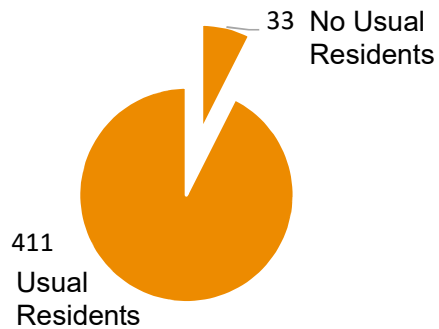


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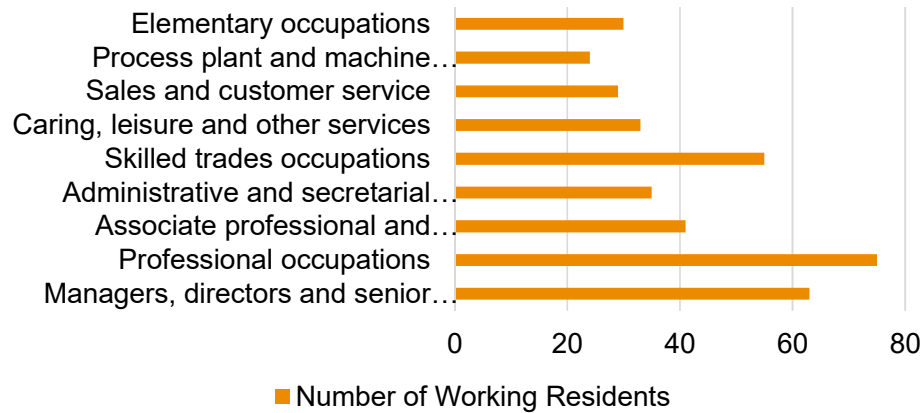

Occupancy of Properties



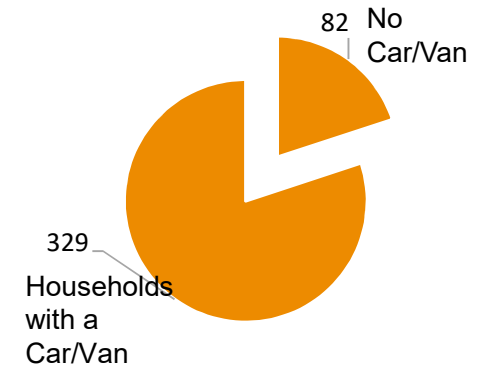

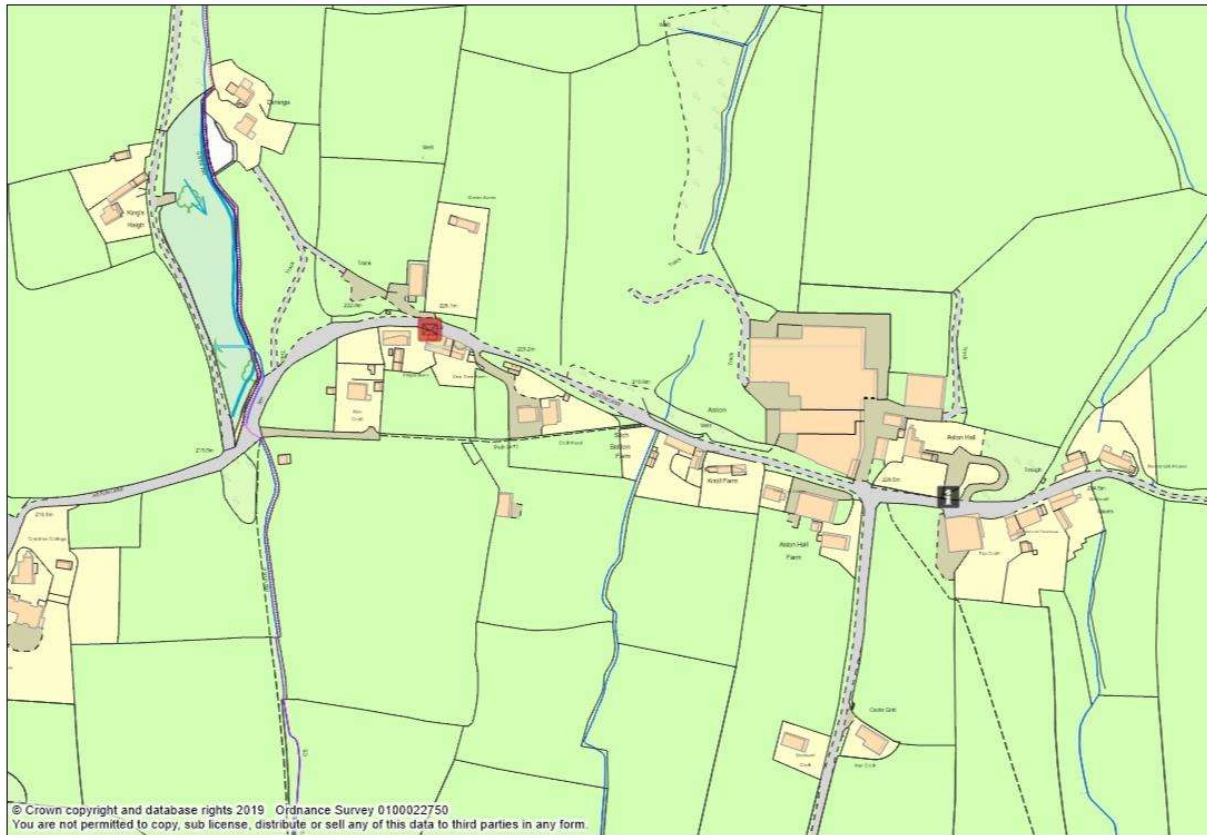

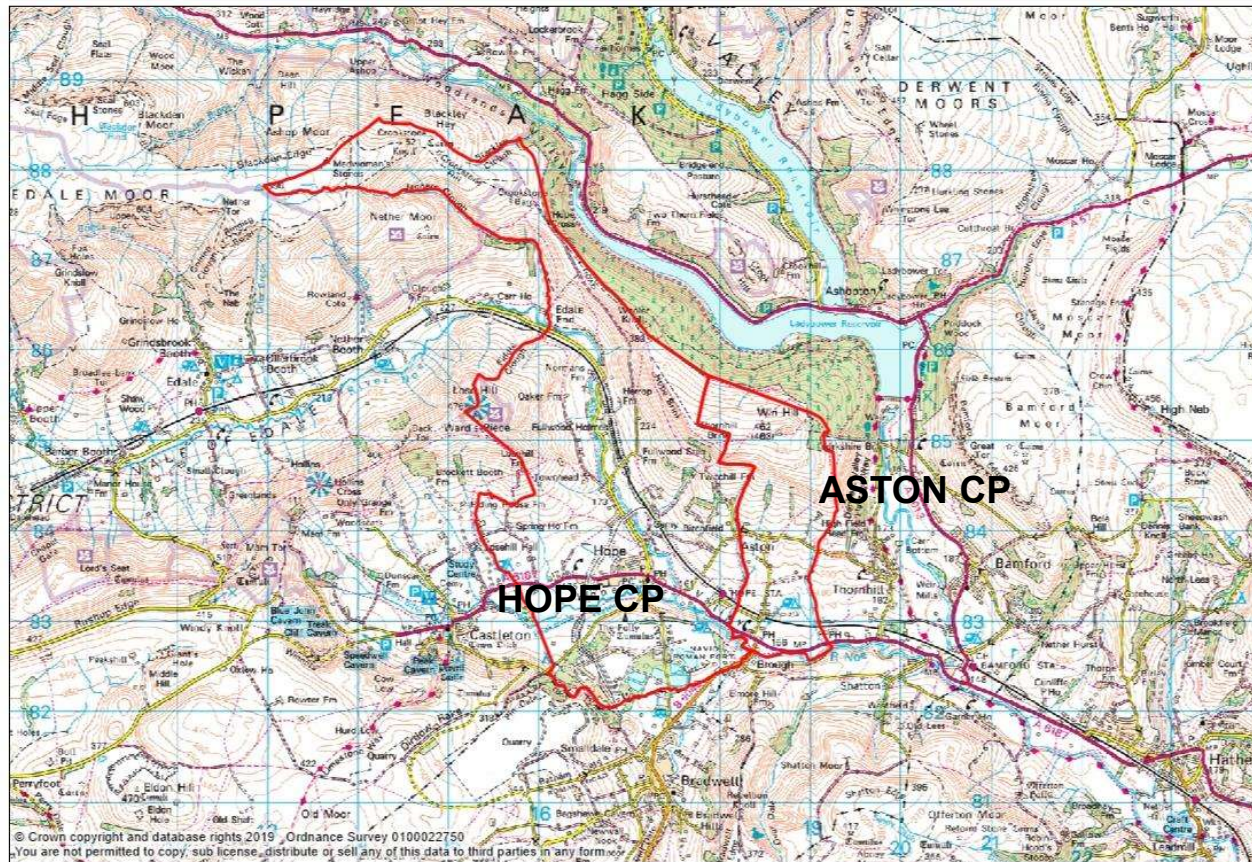


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Hope with Aston Parish Statement
