The parish of Hartington Nether Quarter includes the settlements of Biggin, Newhaven, Friden, Heathcote and Pikehall.

Biggin is located approximately 1.5 miles south east from Hartington and just over 1 mile west of the A515 road. It is a linear settlement in nature, centred along two roads. Historically it is an agricultural settlement.

Newhaven and Friden are small settlements located approximately 1 mile northeast of Biggin. Newhaven is a characterised by 4 farms, a large caravan park and a central service area comprising of a petrol station, restaurant and a large haulage company. Friden, located north of Newhaven is characterised by a group of terraced cottages and farms, and is the location for Eroica Britannia (festival) and DSF Refractories and Minerals company.

Heathcote is located 3/4 mile north west of Biggin and is an agricultural settlement made up of four farms and a number of residential houses.

To the east of Biggin is Pikehall. A small agricultural settlement at the junction of Parwich Lane and the A5012. It straddles 4 parishes; Hartington Nether Quarter, Parwich, Ballidon and Brassington. For the purposes of this study it is included with the parish of Hartington Nether Quarter.

Biggin, Heathcote, Newhaven and Friden are located within the limestone village farmlands character area of the White Peak landscape area. Pikehall is located within the limestone plateau pastures character area of the White Peak. (Landscape Strategy Action Plan, 2009).



Community aspirations

Preserve and enhance the rural character of the parish and the visual appearance of settlements.

Work together as a community to promote community engagement in conjunction with the school, village hall committee, church, local businesses and neighbouring parishes.

Improve entrance signage to settlements, introduce traffic calming, signage and provide a mirror at Dampy's Pinch.

Explore the proposal to provide car parking facilities in the parish to avoid parking

Explore housing options to encourage younger adults to stay living within the parish.

Discourage any further second/holiday homes.


Complete installation of information plaque at Heathcote Mere.


Request regular attendance by a PCSO at village meetings to discuss concerns.

Population and Demographics






The parish of Hartington Nether Quarter has a population of 434 residents (2011 census).








Occupations of Working Adults



Over the last 5 years 46 planning applications have been approved in the parish.




Heathcote and its Services


