

Monyash is located approximately 5 miles west of Bakewell and 8 miles south east of Buxton. It was a small agricultural settlement until the 14th century when lead mining in the locality led to the settlement's growth up until the 19th century. The medieval strip field system defined by dry stone walls has been preserved and contributes to character of the place. Monyash is also characterised by wide roads and green open spaces which provide long views through the settlement.


Monyash is located within the limestone village farmlands character area of the White Peak (Landscape Strategy Action Plan, 2009).







# Households with a Car/Van




