The parish of King Sterndale includes the settlements of King Sterndale, Cowden and Staden. King Sterndale is located approximately 4 miles southeast of Buxton, south of the A6 road with Cowdale and Staden to the west of King Stendale.


King Sterndale is a small settlement, which was the home of the Pickford family who were known for their Pickford Wagons, which transported cobblestones from a family owned quarry to London. The family are still known today as a removals firm. In the mid 19th century the family raised money to build the church and parsonage. The church and village hall are still in use today.



Map of King Sterndale










King Sterndale Parish Boundary (national park boundary shown by blue/yellow line)
