- Our objective for recreation is for a network of high quality sustainable sites and facilities that have promoted understanding and enjoyment by everyone, including residents. Have we achieved this?
- 2. How do we achieve the right balance for visitor parking?
 - Our current approach is restrictive we won't permit new or enlarged facilities unless there is a demonstrable need and consideration of environmental capacity. Is this still the right approach? If it's going wrong, where and how is it going wrong?
- 3. The routes of the Monsal and Trans Pennine trails are currently safeguarded against development for future rail use. Given their popularity as multi-user trails, should they be safeguarded for this use instead?
- 4. How useful have our policies been in delivering our aspirations for sustainable travel? If they have not been useful what can we do differently?
