NOTICE OF EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE 2012
OUTSEATS BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC N^o 48
CONTINUING AS
SHEFFIELD BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC N^o 9
(ALSO KNOWN AS LONG CAUSEWAY)**

WHEN: From 11 July 2012 to 31 July 2012

WHERE: The entire length of the Byway Open to All Traffic No 48 Outseats continuing as Byway Open to All Traffic No 9, Sheffield, (also Known as Long Causeway), between Dennis Knoll and Redmires Reservoir.

REASON: to facilitate public safety owing to a retaining wall requiring repair

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: None available.

A way for pedestrians, cyclists, horseriders and motorcyclists will be maintained whenever possible.

Notice is hereby given under Section 14 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) that the width of these Byways Open to All Traffic shall be limited to 1.5 metres until completion of works to repair the retaining wall.

Derbyshire County Council has consulted the Peak District National Park Authority pursuant to Section 14 (1A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Derbyshire County Council has consulted Sheffield City Council on this proposal.

Access will be maintained at all times for authorised vehicles, access to premises and emergency vehicles.
