Consultation on Stanage and North Lees Estate

A consultation is currently open to anybody who wants a say on the future of the Stanage and North Lees Estate. The 542 hectare Estate is 1.5 miles north of Hathersage and 9.5 miles west of Sheffield in the Dark Peak area of the Peak District National Park (PDNP). Set within wildlife-rich moorland, woodland and farmland the Estate contains the iconic Stanage Edge; Grade II* Listed North Lees Hall and Cruck Barn; estate cottages and farm; as well as a campsite and car parks.

The consultation (which should take between 10-15 minutes to complete) runs until Thursday 13th February 2020, and seeks views on the various aspects of the PDNP owned estate so that a long-term, sustainable plan can be developed. The objectives of this plan will be to continue to care for the Estate and promote understanding in a sustainable way which respects and enhances wildlife, heritage and landscape; as well as using the Estate’s assets to best economic effect.
