his/her representative, may object to the Authority's accounts under the provisions of the Local Audit

and Accountability Act 2014 S.27. The objection must be in writing and written notice of a proposed

objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address given

above and copied to me at the address given below.
