Stoney Middleton is located on the A623 between Eyam and Calver, approximately 5 miles from Bakewell. It is a distinctive village, nestled alongside the steep crags along Middleton Dale. Housing and businesses are located along the A623 or are stepped up along the cliff sides.

Stoney Middleton is mentioned in the Domesday book and has been an area for lead mining dating back to the Romans, and possibly beyond. The production of lead peaked in the 18<sup>th</sup> Century. Other industries included silk and cotton. The village is still home to a shoemaker who specialise in custom made footwear.

Stoney Middleton Conservation Area was designated in 1987.






