Footnote 1: Includes those decided pre-1977 but not started until after 1 Jan 1977.

Footnote 2: Includes those decided pre-1977 but not started until after 1977. This is net commitments i.e lapsed permissions are not included. Low additional commitments in 91/92 could be due to correction of double counting in previous reports. Actual new permissions in 1991/2 was 167.

Between 1st January and the end of 1991/2 in the Peak National Park, permission was granted for 2,377 dwellings (a rate of 167 dwellings a year). This does not include the 247 which lapsed over the period. 1745 dwellings were built (a rate of 122 a year). The rates have fluctuated and dipped since 1988/89, the peak year for both new buildings and commitments. The interim housing policy which restricted provision to 50 dwellings a year was adopted in December 1989. At the end of 1991/92 there were 478 dwelling commitments outstanding on which a start had yet to be made
