

Noise Impact Assessment

Application proposals that raise issues of noise disturbance or are considered to be a noise sensitive development shall be supported by a Noise Impact Assessment prepared by a suitably qualified acoustician. The assessment shall give details of appropriate mitigation measures as appropriate.

Plans, elevational drawings and details of external finishes, will be required in relation to any external equipment.

The <u>Development Management Plan</u> (DMP) Policy DMC14 details the considerations an applicant should give to mitigate harm from noise.
