The Census 2011 groups the data for these parishes together and this is reflected in this report.

Ballidon is a small agricultural settlement consisting of a few farms, a large quarry and some residential properties. It is located at the southeast edge of the Peak District National Park, 5 miles west of Wirksworth. Historically, Ballidon was larger than today's settlement and was focused round the church. The settlement is now located to the north of the church, which stands isolated and vacant. The White Peak meets the Dark Peak Fringe at Ballidon as described in the Landscape Strategy (LSAP 2009).

Aldwark is one of the oldest settlements in the Peak District National Park. It is a farming community which dates back to the Roman times. It is thought to have been quite prosperous during mediaeval times as many of the listed buildings date back to the 17th century.

Ible is a linear settlement, southeast of Grangemill. It is a small farming community.

Ivonbrook Grange parish has a small settlement called Grangemill located at the junction of A5012 (Newhaven to Cromford) and the B5056 (Bakewell to Ashbourne).


Aldwark, Ible and Ivonbrook Grange are all located within the White Peak (LSAP 2009).

Population and Demographics








Ivonbrook Grange Services at Grangemill
