The parish of Bradfield straddles the Peak District National Park and Sheffield. Bradfield Parish is a mix of rural and urban settlements. Whilst Low Bradfield and High Bradfield are physically separate, the communities work together and share services.

High Bradfield is a small village, northeast of Sheffield. It was historically an agricultural village and dates back to the 12th century. The presence of the church was also a contributing factor to its development as a settlement. The village is characterised by 18th and 19th century farming and cottage properties and has a public house and church as its focal points.

Low Bradfield is a small village located at the bottom of the Loxley valley, northwest of Sheffield, where the Agden Beck meets the Dale Dike to form the River Loxley. It was historically an agricultural village and developed around the manorial corn mill on the banks of the River Loxley. The construction of the four Bradfield Dale reservoirs also contributed to population growth in the area between 1860 and 1875.

At the southern point of the parish within the National Park is Hollow Meadows, a small farming settlement nestled between the A57 (Manchester Road) and Long Lane, to the east of Sheffield.

Low Bradfield and High Bradfield Conservation Area boundaries were designated in 1981 and accompanying appraisals in March 2010.

Bradfield parish is located within the slopes and valleys with woodlands of the Dark Peak: Yorkshire Fringe character area of the Landscape Strategy (LSAP 2009).




Population and Demographics






Low Bradfield and its Services



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Bradfield Parish Boundary




