

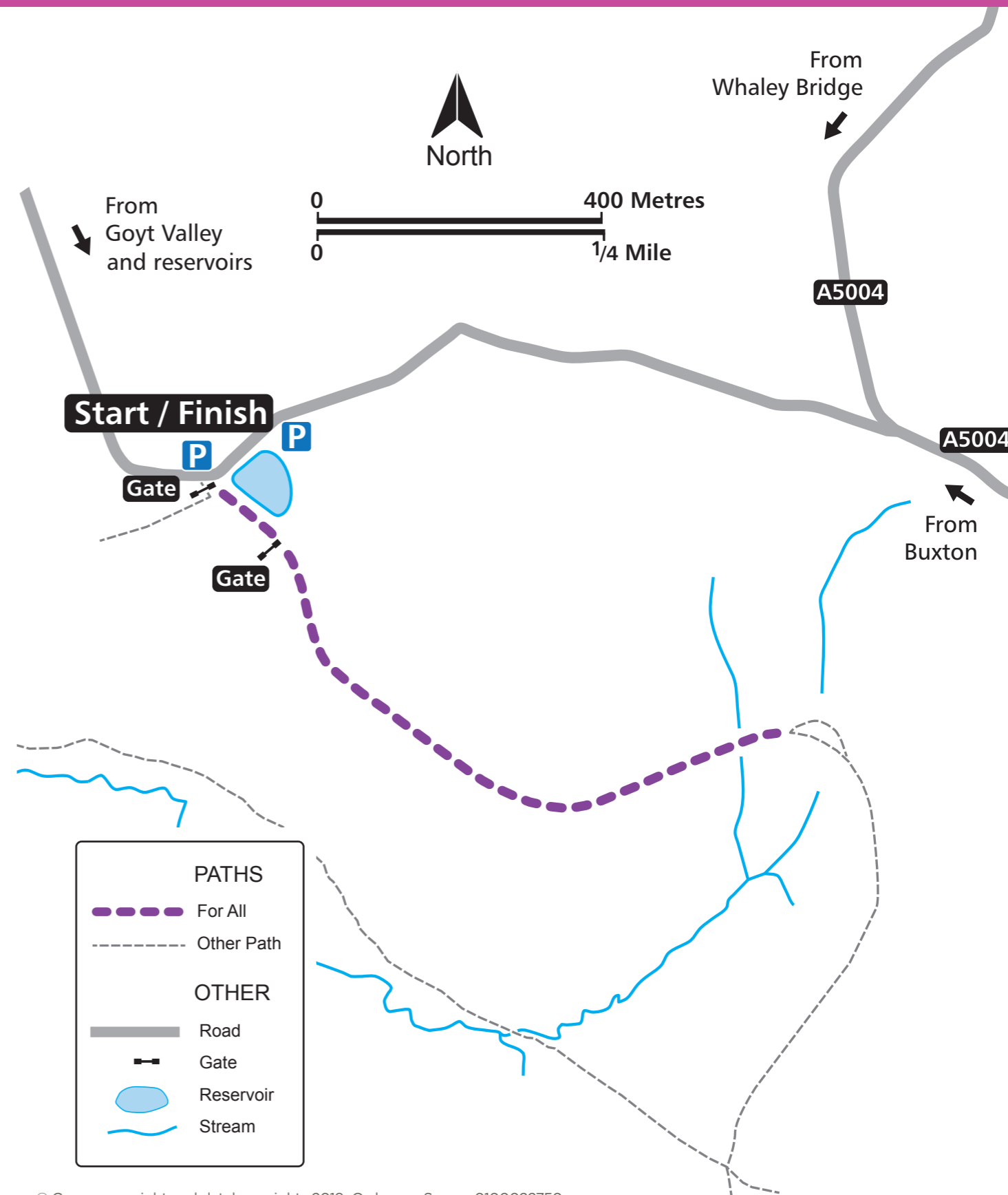
A former railway line providing elevated views across the moors and woodlands of the Goyt Valley.

**Access For All Route:**

- ① Pass to the left of the field gate from the car park opposite.
- ② Continue above the lake and along the track to a lone tree and the embankment.

- i** The former Cromford and High Peak Railway linked the Cromford and the Peak Forest canals.
- i** The reservoir provided water for the stationary steam engine, which hauled trains up the incline, and was also used as an ice rink in Victorian times.
- i** The bubbling call of the curlew may be heard across the moors.

**Distance:** 1 km to the embankment  
**Start Point:** Car Park at Goyt's Lane, via the A5004 north-west of Buxton  
**OS Grid Ref:** SK 0232 7515  
**Post Code:** SK17 6GJ  
**Nearest Facilities:** Buxton
