



Ashford is located approximately 3 miles west of Bakewell. To the south are the River Wye and the A6 road.

The Conservation Area (CA) was designated in September 2000. The CA appraisal states that there is archaeological evidence of there being a settlement dating back 7000 years. Ashford village has grown as a result of lead mining and industry in the area, of particular note was the production of marble and stockings. Ashford was also an important crossing point over the River Wye for the movement of goods to and from Derby.

Ashford in the Water straddles the White Peak and the Derwent Valley character areas within the Peak District Landscape Characteristic Assessment (LSAP 2009). The area is described as riverside meadows and valley farmlands with villages within the LSAP.




Ashford in the Water and Sheldon parishes have a combined population of 559 residents (2011 census).

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



Occupancy of Properties No Usual




Employment






Ashford in the Water Services
