Within the parish of Whaley Bridge is Fernilee, a small settlement which is partly within the National Park. It is located north of the Goyt Valley, less than 2 miles south of Whaley Bridge and approximately 4 miles northwest of Buxton. To the southwest is Fernilee Reservoir. The areas around Fernilee are very popular with walkers. The focus of this report is on Fernilee and the surrounding area within the National Park. The census data is captured at output area level to align it as closely to the settlement of Fernilee and the farmsteads and properties in the surrounding National park area.

Fernilee is located within two landscape character areas; the slopes and valleys with woodland and the reservoir valleys with woodland character areas of the South West Peak (LSAP 2009).










Over the last 5 years 10 planning applications have been approved in Tintwistle parish (within the national park).


