Rowarth is a small settlement located just over 1.5 miles northwest of Hayfield and approximately 3 miles east of Marple. It is characterised by a large open area in the middle which is currently used as a playground. Residential properties are largely located to the north consisting of two rows of terraces and a few detached properties.

Rowarth is located within the valley pastures with industry character area of the Dark Peak as described in the Peak District Landscape Characteristic Assessment (LSAP 2009).




# Population and Demographics




