

# Langsettt



Linger at Langsettt's oasis or loop along the woodland water-front promenade.

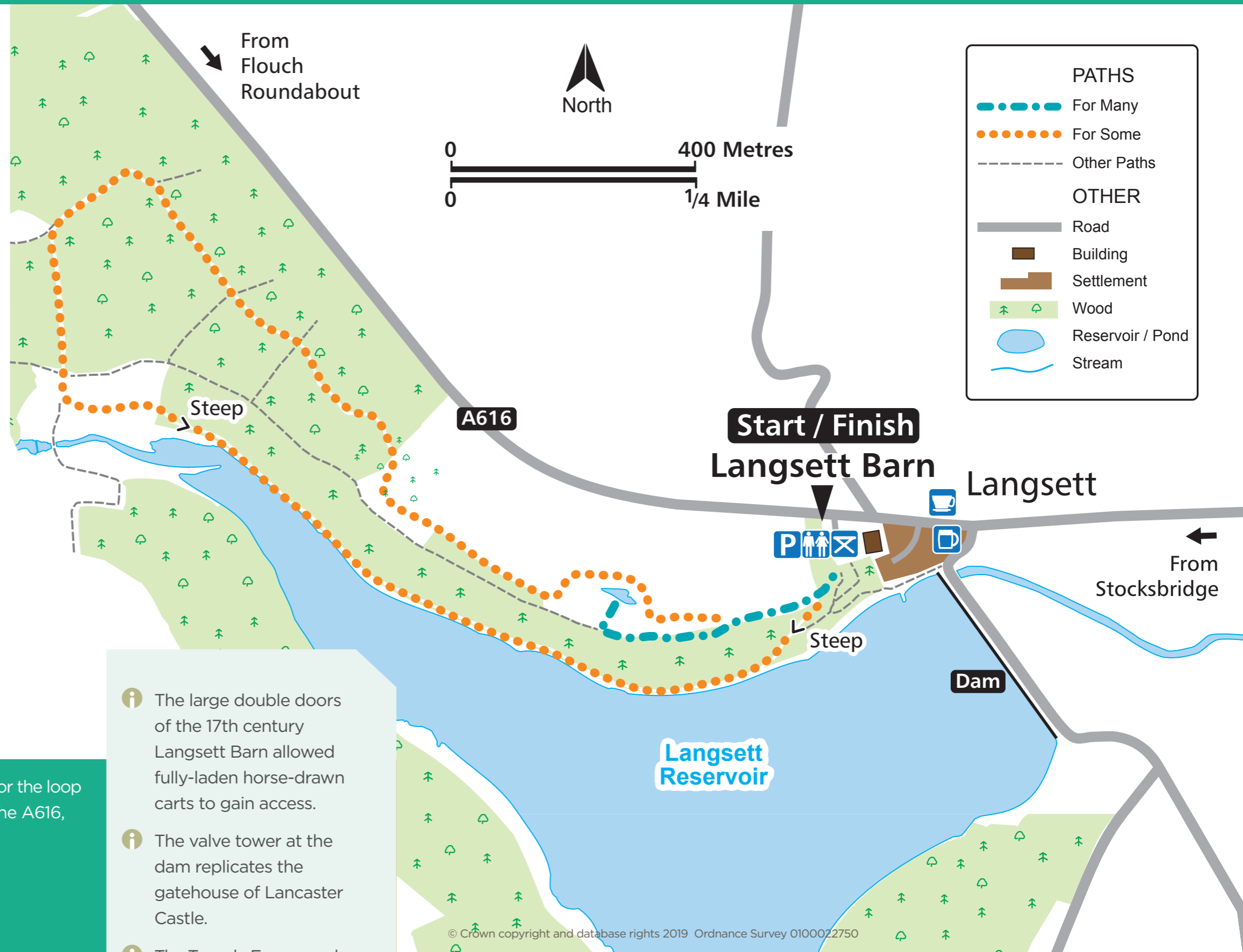
**Access for Many Route:**

- ① Start from the rear right-hand corner of the car park and follow the field-edge path until a path is met on the left.
- ② Descend along the woodland path until a turning on the right to a clearing with a pond and seating.

**Access for Some Route:**

- ① Start from the rear right-hand corner of the car park and take the lower path.
- ② Go through the gateposts down a steep slope to the reservoir side.
- ③ Continue along a well-surfaced level woodland path and up a climb to meet a forest track.
- ④ Turn right and follow the track uphill through the woodland before continuing parallel to, but at some distance from, the main road before meeting the field-edge path back to the car park.

**Distance:** 480 m to the pond & 3.3 km for the loop  
**Start Point:** Langsettt Barn Car Park, off the A616, west of Stocksbridge  
**OS Grid Ref:** SE 2104 0048  
**Post Code:** S36 4GY  
**Nearest Facilities:** Langsettt
