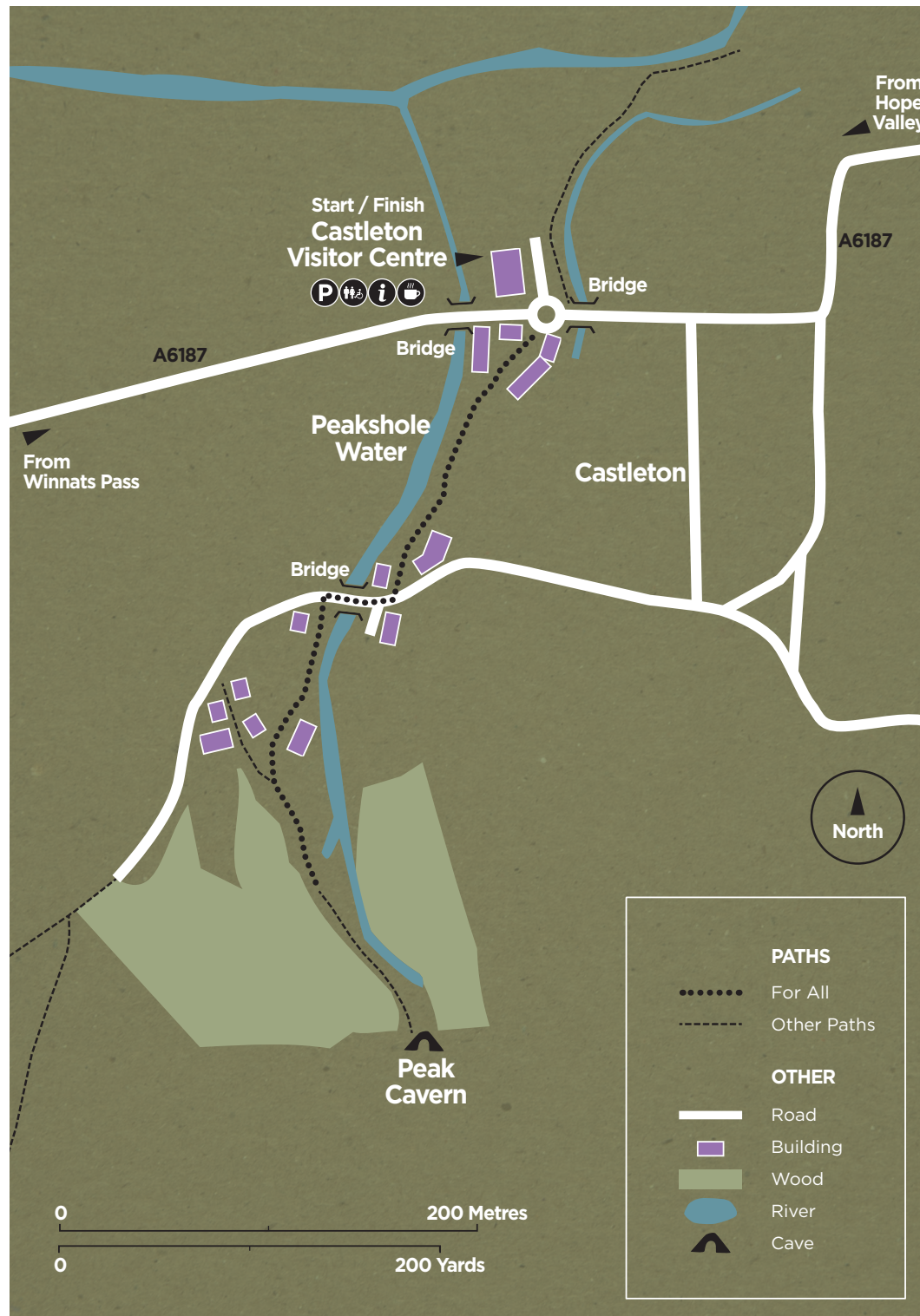
ACCESS FOR ALL

Discover one of the wonders of the Peak District by following the stream to its source via Castleton's historic passageways. Road-crossing at the start and a short section with local traffic.

DISTANCE:
350m.

START POINT:
Castleton Visitor Centre.

NEAREST FACILITIES:
Castleton.



- 1 Head between the café and jewellers opposite the Visitor Centre to meet the stream. Keep the stream on your right.
- 2 Turn right at the T-junction to cross the stream by the bridge.
- 3 Turn left immediately after the bridge and with the stream on your left follow the rising path round the front of the houses to the largest natural cave entrance in the UK.

ALTERNATIVE:
Consider exploring underground with a mobility-friendly entrance tour. The path steepens to the cave entrance.
